W. J. BROCKELBANK received his B.A. degree from Haverford College in 1919 and his LL.B. from Harvard Law School in 1923. He has been a Professor of Law at the University of Idaho since 1945. Previously he had been on the law faculties of the Universities of Kansas, Alabama and Pittsburgh.

The international aspects of Professor Brockelbank's background include work with the International Corporation Co. in Paris from 1925-28 and counselor at law in Paris from 1934-5. He also was associated with the firm of Tiffin, DuMoulin & Brown in Vancouver, B. C. and lectured at the University of British Columbia from 1941-42. He is a Lincoln's Inn Barrister of Law and received the State doctorate in Paris in 1934.

Professor Brockelbank authored the Kansas Annotations to the Restatements of Trusts and Conflict of Laws and is a frequent contributor to various legal periodicals. He is a member of the Idaho and American Bar Associations.
